




## A. The Sower's Activity (26)

## B. The Growth Mystery (27-28)


- 1) We can't understand **how** it grows.
  - 27 "and he goes to bed at night and gets up by day, and the seed sprouts and grows-how, he himself does not know."

## B. The Growth Mystery (27-28)

- 2) We can't make it grow.
  - 28 "The soil produces crops by itself; first the blade, then the head, then the mature grain in the head."
  - Cf. Acts 12:10 "When they had passed the first and second guard, they came to the iron gate that leads into the city, which opened for them <u>by itself</u>; and they went out and went along one street, and immediately the angel departed from him."
  - Cf. 1 Cor. 3:6 "I planted, Apollos watered, but God was causing the growth."
  - John 3:1ff
