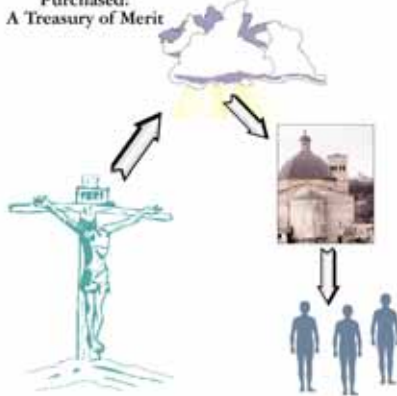

Peter Lombard: The Seven Sacraments Explained

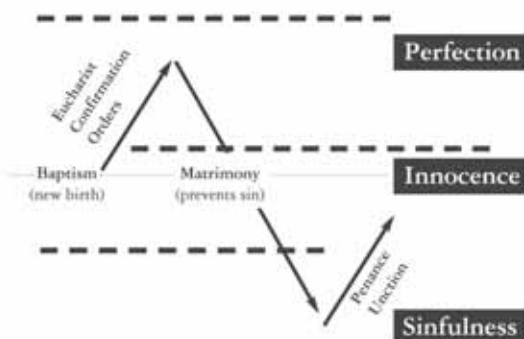
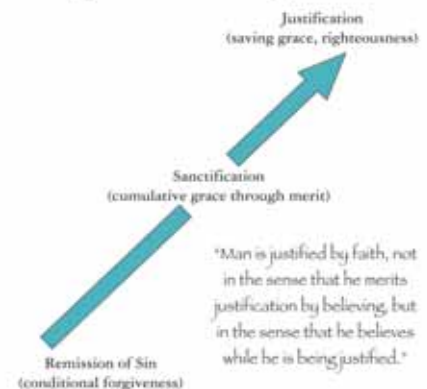

Thomas Aquinas: The Steps to Salvation

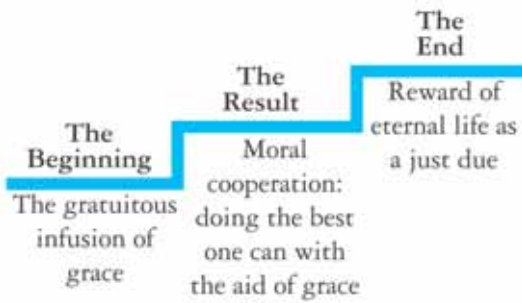

The Luther Rose: The Gospel in Symbol

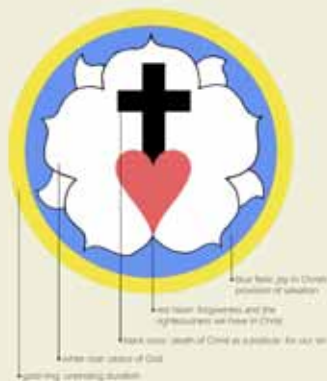
