<u>The Purpose of the Gospel of John</u> - John 20:30-31 - "Therefore many other signs Jesus also performed in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; but these have been written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing you may have life in His name."

The sequence of events in John 4:27-42 is:

Jesus is still talking with the Samaritan woman

The disciples return from their grocery shopping

The Samaritan woman abruptly departs and starts to summon the Samaritan men

Jesus talks with and teaches His disciples

Many Samaritans believe in Jesus because of the Samaritan woman's testimony

The Samaritans come to Jesus and invite Him to stay with them

Jesus remains there for two days

Many more believe in Jesus because of His word

Their conclusion: Jesus is indeed the Savior of the world

So what are the implications for us?

- 1. With His authority Matthew 28:19-20 "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."
- 2. In view of final judgment Mark 16:15-16 "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation. He who has believed and has been baptized shall be saved; but he who has disbelieved shall be condemned."
- 3. <u>In fulfillment of prophecy</u> Luke 24:44-49 "These are My words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things which are written about Me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms must be fulfilled.""Thus it is written, that the Christ would suffer and rise again from the dead the third day, and that repentance for forgiveness of sins would be proclaimed in His name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things. And behold, I am sending forth the promise of My Father upon you;...."
