**Memory Verse:** John 12:28 “Father, glorify Your name.” Then a voice came out of heaven: “I have both glorified it, and will glorify it again.”

**Theme:** In Jesus' final revelation of Himself to the crowd, He teaches of five results of His death on the cross: to produce spiritual fruit, to glorify the Father, to bring judgment, to defeat Satan and to draw all men to Himself

**12:35-36**

**Colossians 1:10** so that you will walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, to please *Him* in all respects, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;
