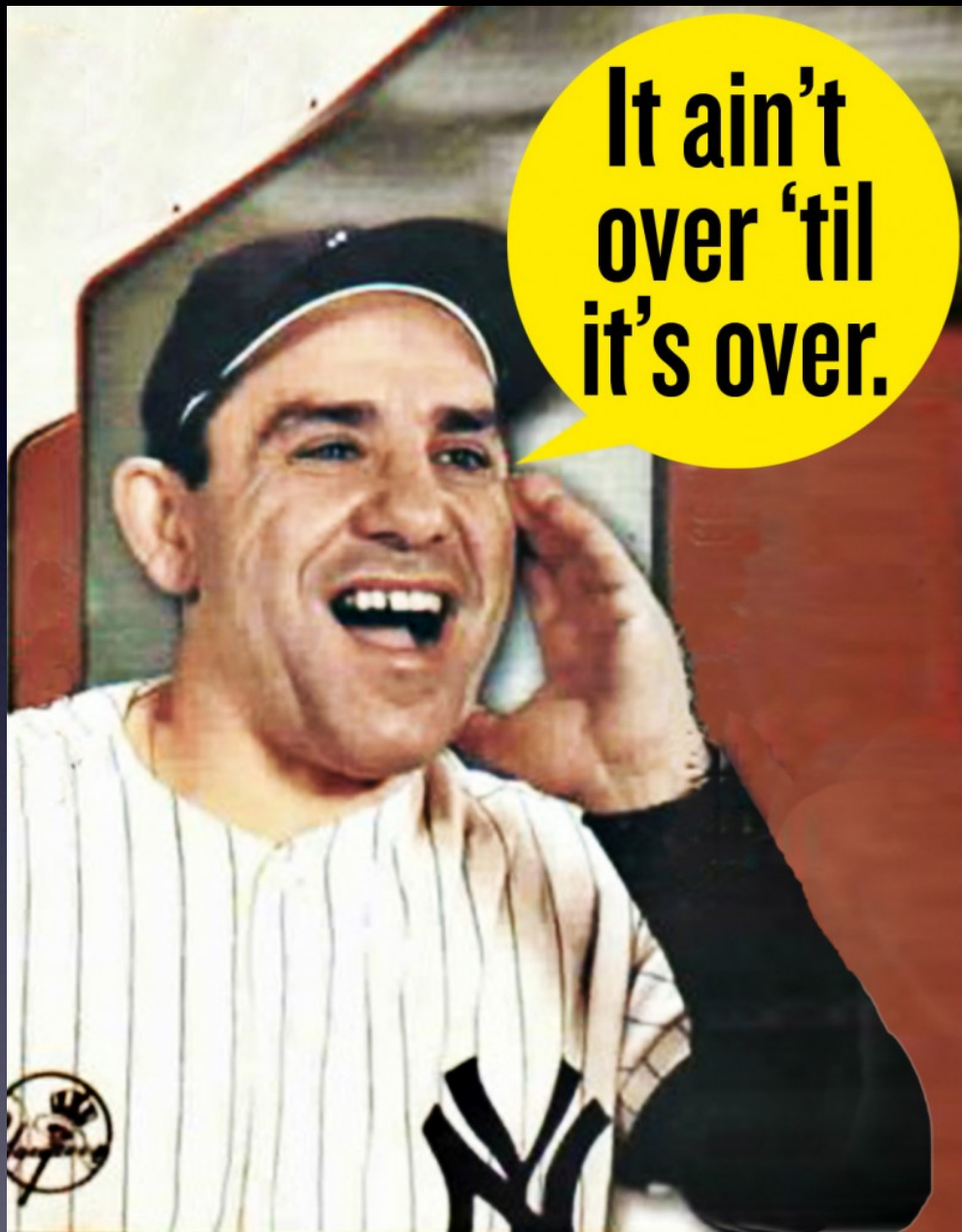

1 Corinthians 15:1-8

Now I make known to you,
brethren, the **gospel** which I
preached to you, which also you
received, in which also you stand,
by which also you are saved, if you
hold fast the word which I preached
to you, unless you believed in vain.

1 Corinthians 15:1-8

For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that **Christ died for our sins** according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that **He was raised on the third day** according to the Scriptures, and that He appeared toPeter and the disciples plus to more than 500 at one time.

The Gospel

1. Christ died for our sins

(according to the Scriptures)

PROOF: He was buried

2. He was raised on the third day

(according to the Scriptures)

PROOF: He appeared to many

1 Corinthians 15:13-14, 17

But if there is no resurrection of the dead, not even Christ has been raised; and if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is vain, your faith also is vain.....and if Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins.

1 Corinthians 15:20-22

But now Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who are asleep. For since by a man came death, by a man also came the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, so also **in Christ all will be made alive.**

The Lord Calls and Cares for His Own

John 21:1-14

John 21:1, 14

1. After these things Jesus manifested Himself again to the disciples at the Sea of Tiberias, and He manifested Himself **in this way**.

14. This is now the third time that Jesus was manifested to the disciples, **after He was raised from the dead**.

The Introduction - John 21:1, 14

1. He went to them as promised to Galilee

2. He manifested Himself in a particular manner

3. He manifested Himself AFTER being raised from the dead

But the eleven disciples proceeded to Galilee, to the mountain which Jesus had designated.

John 21:3

Simon Peter said to them, “I am going fishing.” They said to him, “We will also come with you.” They went out and got into **the boat**; and that night they caught nothing.

The disciples go back to fishing

John 21:2-3

What did they do?

1. Peter decided to go fishing and the rest followed
2. They fished all night and caught nothing


John 21:4-5

But when the day was now breaking,
Jesus stood on the beach; yet the
disciples did not know that it was
Jesus.

So Jesus said to them, “Children,
you do not have any fish, do you?”
They answered Him, “No.”

John 21:6

And He said to them, “Cast the net on the right-hand side of the boat and you will find a catch.” So they cast, and then they were not able to haul it in because of the great number of fish.



John 21:7

Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, “It is the Lord.” So when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put his outer garment on (for he was stripped for work), and threw himself into the sea.

John 21:8

But the other disciples came in the little boat, for they were not far from the land, but about one hundred yards away, dragging the net full of fish.

Jesus calls the disciples back to Himself - v. 4-13

1. A Reminder of their Call to Follow Him - v. 4-8

Luke 5:1-11



John 21:9-11

So when they got out on the land, they saw a charcoal fire already laid and fish placed on it, and bread.

Jesus said to them, “Bring some of the fish which you have now caught.”

Simon Peter went up and drew the net to land, full of large fish, a hundred and fifty-three; and although there were so many, the net was not torn.

John 21:12-13

Jesus said to them, “Come and have breakfast.” None of the disciples ventured to question Him, “Who are You?” knowing that it was the Lord.

Jesus came and took the bread and gave it to them, and the fish likewise.

Jesus calls the disciples back to Himself - v. 4-13

1. A Reminder of their Call to Follow Him - v. 4-8

2. A Reminder of His Care for them - v. 9-13

Implications for us

1. Jesus calls us to follow Him not just to get saved but also to obey and serve Him
2. Jesus lovingly cares and provides for His people
