In an interview published by the Argentine Weekly "Viva", the pope listed his top ten secrets for happiness. One of them was quite shocking in view of the Great Commission given to the church by our Lord Jesus Christ. Pope Francis disagrees with the true Head of the Church in saying that we should not proselytize. He said we should respect others' beliefs because "the worst thing of all is religious proselytism, which paralyzes." The word "proselytize" means to try to convert somebody to a religious faith. The pope said "the church grows by attraction, not proselytizing."










Salvation by grace thru faith in Christ
Israel Church




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Access thru the temple




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- 5. The book of Acts gives us the <u>framework</u> for the letters of Paul
- 6. While the gospel of Luke is about what Jesus <u>began</u> to do and teach, Acts of the Apostles records what Jesus <u>continued</u> to do through the ministry of the <u>Holy Spirit</u>



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- 4. The disciples focused on the physical kingdom of God asking, when will it happen?
- 5. Jesus <u>redirected</u> the disciples to their upcoming ministry

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Matthew 28:18-20 - And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

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Mark 16:15 - And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation. He who has believed and has been baptized shall be saved; but he who has disbelieved shall be condemned."

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Luke 24:46-47 - and He said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ would suffer and rise again from the dead the third day, and that repentance for forgiveness of sins would be proclaimed in His name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem."

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John 17:18 - "As You sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world."

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- 4. John emphasizes Jesus as the model for their ministry
- 5. Luke, in Acts, emphasizes the Holy Spirit's <u>power</u> for ministry and the world-wide scope and <u>method of expansion</u> of ministry




The Witness to Jerusalem Acts 1:1 - 8:3



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
The Witness to Judea and Samaria

The Witness to the ends of the earth Acts 12:25 - 21:14




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The Ascension of Jesus Christ - Acts 1:9-11
