
### FEASTS - BOOKEND MAJOR JEWISH HOLIDAYS


# **JOEL**

- MEANING: "Yahweh is God"
- AUTHOR: Joel
- TIME WRITTEN: About 835 B.C.
- OBSERVATIONS:
  - Son of Pethuel "Persuaded of God").
  - Early prophet of Judah.
  - God's spokesman during the reign of King Joash
  - Time period 835-796 b.c.
  - Theme Mercy Judgment Disasters
  - Locusts Plagues Famine Raging fires Invading armies Celestial phenomena
- "The Day of the Lord is indeed great and very awesome, And who can endure it." 2:11
