<u>Theme</u>: God demands that His church maintain moral purity, resist Satan's temptation and demonstrate genuine faith.

Key Verse: Acts 5:3 But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit and to keep back *some* of the price of the land?

I. The Sinful Act Exposed

1-5

- 1. It was not a sin:
 - a. To own property
 - b. To sell property and keep the proceeds
 - c. To sell property and give a portion of the proceeds to the church
- 2. It is sinful:
 - a. To yield to Satan's temptation
 - b. To lie to the Holy Spirit
 - c. To conspire together to deceive men in order to exalt yourself.

II. The Judgment Rendered

5-6

- 1. After Ananias' sin was exposed, God's judgment followed quickly.
- 2. The execution of judgment caused all the people to fear the wrath of God.
- 3. Ananias' body was buried immediately.

III. The Process Repeated

7-11

- 1. After Sapphira's sin was exposed, God's judgment followed quickly.
- 2. Sapphira's body was buried immediately.
- 3. The execution of judgment caused the church and others to fear God's power.

IV. The Church Grows

12-16

- 1. The apostles were empowered to do many miracles to authenticate their ministry.
- 2. The explosive growth of the church continued, in spite of persecution and judgment.
- 3. Vast numbers of people, expanding beyond Jerusalem, were being <u>impacted</u> by the apostle's ministry.

V. Application

- 1. Believers are to maintain moral purity in the church.
- 2. Believers are to resist Satan's temptations.
- 3. Believers are to demonstrate a genuine faith motivated by the love of God.
