Acts 5:12, 14, 16a

At the hands of the apostles many signs and wonders were taking place among the people; and they were all with one accord in Solomon's portico......And all the more believers in the Lord, multitudes of men and women, were constantly added to their number Also the people from the cities in the vicinity of Jerusalem were coming together

Theme Statement

Unbelievers, although dead in their sins, actively pursue their own desires, deny their sin against God, reject the Gospel, fight against God but through the power of the Holy Spirit, some will respond in repentance and faith in the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, we must be faithful and persistent in presenting the Gospel to others in the power of the Holy Spirit.

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John 12:9-11 - The large crowd of the Jews then learned that He was there; and they came, not for Jesus' sake only, but that they might also see Lazarus, whom He raised from the dead. But the chief priests planned to put Lazarus to death also; because on account of him many of the Jews were going away and were believing in Jesus.

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- 3. During the night, an angel of the Lord released the apostles from prison and commanded them to teach the whole gospel of eternal life in the temple area and they obeyed

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- 3. The captain of the temple guard and his men <u>carefully</u> brought the apostles back before the Sanhedrin
- 4. The high priest was <u>disrespectful</u> to Jesus, charged the apostles with <u>disobedience</u> to the authority of the Sanhedrin and charged the apostles with <u>blaming the death of Jesus</u> on the Sanhedrin

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Matthew 27:20, 25 - But the chief priests and the elders persuaded the crowds to ask for Barabbas and to put Jesus to death.....When Pilate saw that he was accomplishing nothing, but rather that a riot was starting, he took water and washed his hands in front of the crowd, saying, "I am innocent of this Man's blood; see to that yourselves." And all the people said, "His blood shall be on us and on our children!"

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Acts 4:19-20 - "But Peter and John answered and said to them, "Whether it is right in the sight of God to give heed to you rather than to God, you be the judge; for we cannot stop speaking about what we have seen and heard."

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Mark 2:5-7 -And Jesus seeing their faith said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven." But some of the scribes were sitting there and reasoning in their hearts, "Why does this man speak that way? He is blaspheming; who can forgive sins but God alone?"

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Acts 2:37 - Now when they heard this, they were pierced to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brethren, death by what shall we do?"
