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In his Apologeticus, he wrote, "the blood of the martyrs is the seed of the church"

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


Theme Statement




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


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




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"What an utter travesty this is of Christianity! Here is the truth: 'They went everywhere preaching the word.' 1 Corinthians 12:13 - For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.

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Acts 1:4-5 - Gathering them together, He commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for what the Father had promised, "Which," He said, "you heard of from Me; for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."

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- 4. Acts 19:1-7 This is the baptism of the Spirit of God on unbelieving Gentiles

Ephesians 2:13-16

But now in Christ Jesus you who formerly were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. For He Himself is our peace, who made both groups into one and broke down the barrier of the dividing wall, by abolishing in His flesh the enmity, which is the Law of commandments contained in ordinances, so that in Himself He might make the two into one new man, thus establishing peace, and might reconcile them both in one body to God through the cross, by it having put to death the enmity.

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- 2. Peter rebuked Simon for the <u>evil intentions</u> of Simon's heart and called him to <u>repent</u> and pray to the Lord for <u>forgiveness</u>
- 3. Instead, Simon asked Peter to pray that <u>nothing bad</u> would happen to Simon

- 3. Salvation is a personal response to the Gospel in repentance and faith in the Lord Jesus Christ
