Romans 2:25-29

A. Because You Still Need Perfect Obedience (25-27)

- There are only 2 potential paths to being right with God:

 justification by works or b) justification by faith in Christ.
- Trusting in a ritual for your salvation in whole or in part
 means you are pursuing justification by works.
- 3. If you want to be justified by works, you must keep <u>all</u> of God's law perfectly.
- 4. If you fail to keep God's law perfectly, you are guilty of breaking it all and will face God's wrath at the judgment.

- III. Claiming faith in God and performing religious rituals will not allow you to escape God's wrath (25-29).
 - A. Because You Still Need Perfect Obedience (25-27)
 - B. Because You Still Need a New Heart (28-29)
 - 1) Negative: The Evidence of Belonging to God's True People <u>Is Not External</u> (28).
 - 2) Positive: The Evidence of Belonging to God's True People <u>Is</u> Your Heart (29).
