Memory Verse: Isaiah 53:1 Who has believed our message? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?

Theme: Believers are to look forward to God's promised Righteous King who will rule a magnificent Kingdom.

I. The Righteous King

11:1-5

- 1. The King will come from the Davidic royal line of Jesse.
- 2. The King will be indwelt with the Holy Spirit, who will empower Him to reign:
 - a. With wisdom and understanding
 - b. With counsel and strength
 - c. With knowledge and fear of the Lord.
- 3. The King will have divine perception to make accurate judgments.
- 4. The King will make equitable judgments for the poor and afflicted people.
- 5. The King will destroy the wicked, in order to maintain justice.

II. His Magnificent Kingdom

11:6-16

- 1. His Kingdom will be peaceful, where animals will live together in harmony.
 - a. Wolves will live with a lambs without eating them
 - b. Leopards will lie down with a young goats without eating them
 - c. Calves, young lions and fatlings will cooperate together and follow a little boy
 - d. Cows and bears graze together and their offspring will lie down together
 - e. Lions will eat same straw that provides nourishment for oxen
 - e. Children will play with snakes without being bitten
- 2. His Kingdom will be full of people with knowledge of the Lord.
- 3. His Kingdom will be comprised of people from every nation.
- 4. His Kingdom will include the faithful remnant of dispersed Israel, recovered by the Lord
 - a. The southern two tribes will be reunited with the northern ten tribes
 - b. The united kingdom will be made the dominant world power by the Lord
 - c. The Lord will deliver His remnant as He delivered them from Egypt's oppression

III. His People's Joyful Response

12:1-6

- 1. I will give thanks to God for His provision for my reconciliation with Him.
- 2. I will trust in God for His salvation and my strength in order to not fear men.
- 3. I will evangelize the lost by testifying of God's great grace and mercy.
- 4. I will worship God for the excellent things He has done
- 5. I will rejoice in being in the presence of the Holy One of Israel
