Practical lessons from Psalm 100...

- 1) Eat your thanksgiving meal with the same attitude as the OT worshipper, as if you are having a meal with God.
- 2) Rehearse to others what you're thankful for.
- 3) Set aside time to sing to and about God.
- 4) Take time to give thanks directly to God.
- 5) Make God the focus of your Thanksgiving.
 - What He has done: His creation, providential care, and sovereign grace.
 - Who He is: His goodness, steadfast love, and faithfulness.
