*“Because he has become arrogant toward the LORD” (Jeremiah 48:42b)*

Isaiah 15-16

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Memory Verses: Isaiah 53:1-2 - Who has believed our message? And to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed? For He grew up before Him like a tender shoot, and like a root out of parched ground; He has no stately form or majesty that we should look upon Him, nor appearance that we should be attracted to Him.

Theme Statement: The LORD declares that certain judgment is coming for sin, especially the sin of pride, but He also offers deliverance from final judgment through the steadfast love of His coming Messiah King.

### Judgment is Certain - Isaiah 15:1 - 16:4a

### Deliverance is Coming - Isaiah 16:4b-5

### Judgment is Imminent - Isaiah 16:6-14

1. Moab's sin is their \_\_\_\_\_ - v. 6

Jeremiah 48:42 - "Moab will be destroyed from being a people because he has become arrogant toward the Lord."

2. THEREFORE Moab will \_\_\_\_\_ over the desolation of their land - v. 7-8
3. THEREFORE the LORD will weep bitterly for Moab's \_\_\_\_\_ - v. 9-10
4. THEREFORE the LORD's \_\_\_\_\_ is expressed toward Moab's rejection of the true God for the god Chemosh - v. 11-12
5. The LORD set a specific time of \_\_\_\_\_ from the writing of this prophecy for the destruction of Moab with only a small and feeble \_\_\_\_\_ remaining - v. 13-14

### Implications
