We are to walk in God's way which is to turn from our sin of relying on temporal resources and to trust in Him Who has absolute sovereign control over all of our circumstances.



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
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
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- 3. The LORD God <u>Teacher</u> will then guide His people in the <u>way</u> they are to <u>walk</u>
- 4. The LORD will complete the day of great slaughter and usher in His millennial kingdom with great blessing and healing






MacRae - "The Millennium is not to come in gradually through the slow continuous spread of the Gospel, but is to be introduced by a great sudden act of God's power."
