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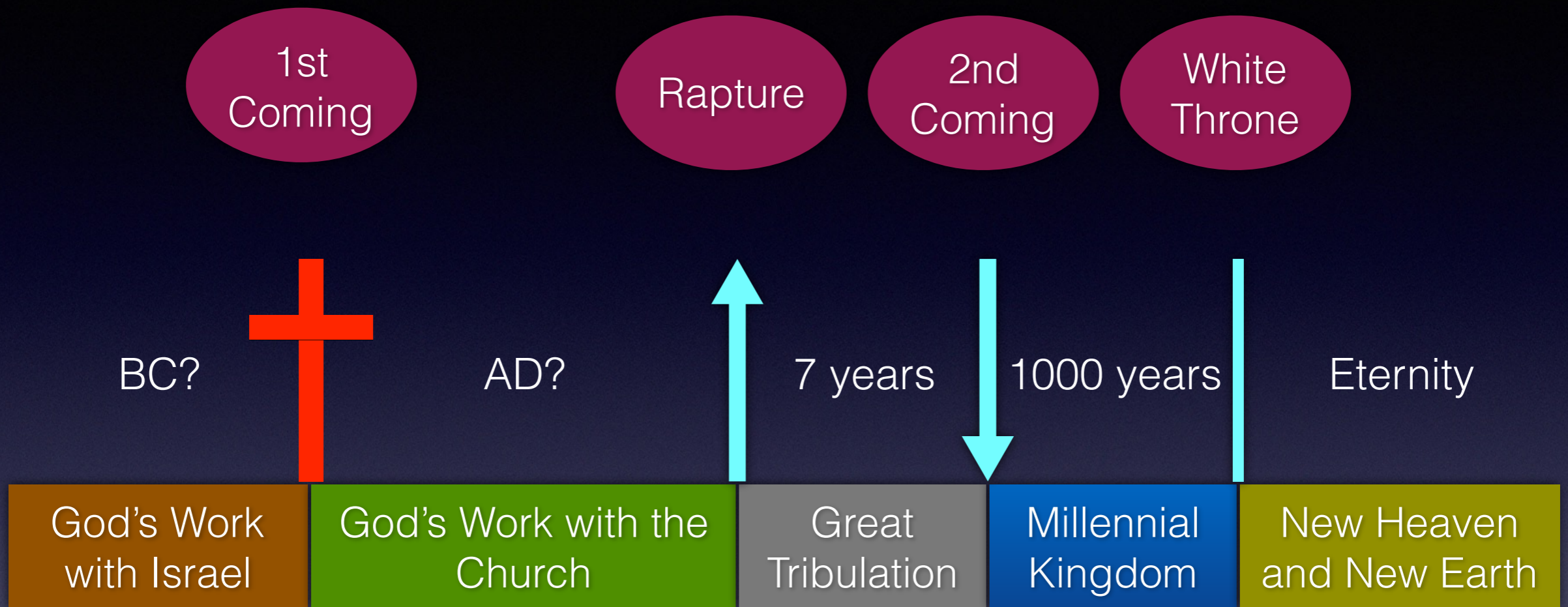
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5. Isaiah 33 - "Woe to you, O destroyer, as soon as you finish destroying, you will be destroyed."



Theme Statement

The Lord God gives ample and clear warning in His Word regarding the consequences of sin. In the end, there are only two final outcomes, either enduring the eternal wrath of God or being saved with gladness from the wrath of God through repentance and faith in the Redeemer, Jesus Christ.

The Wrath of the LORD
Isaiah 34

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Obadiah 10–12 - "Because of violence to your brother Jacob, You will be covered with shame, and you will be cut off forever. On the day that you stood aloof, on the day that strangers carried off his wealth, and foreigners entered his gate and cast lots for Jerusalem—You too were as one of them. Do not gloat over your brother's day, the day of his misfortune. And do not rejoice over the sons of Judah in the day of their destruction; yes, do not boast in the day of their distress.

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Esau represents the non-elect - Romans 9



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Calvin - He compares it to sacrifices, for animals are slain in sacrifice for the worship and honour of God, and in like manner the destruction of this people will also tend to the glory of God. And here he confirms what was formerly said about judgment, for when God executes his judgments, he shews forth his glory; so that the destruction of wicked men is justly compared to "sacrifices," which belonged to his worship.

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Revelation 19:1-3 - After these things I heard something like a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, "Hallelujah! Salvation and glory and power belong to our God; because His judgments are true and righteous; for He has judged the great harlot who was corrupting the earth with her immorality, and He has avenged the blood of His bond-servants on her." And a second time they said, "Hallelujah! Her smoke rises up forever and ever."

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The Lord's creation will be glad - v. 1a



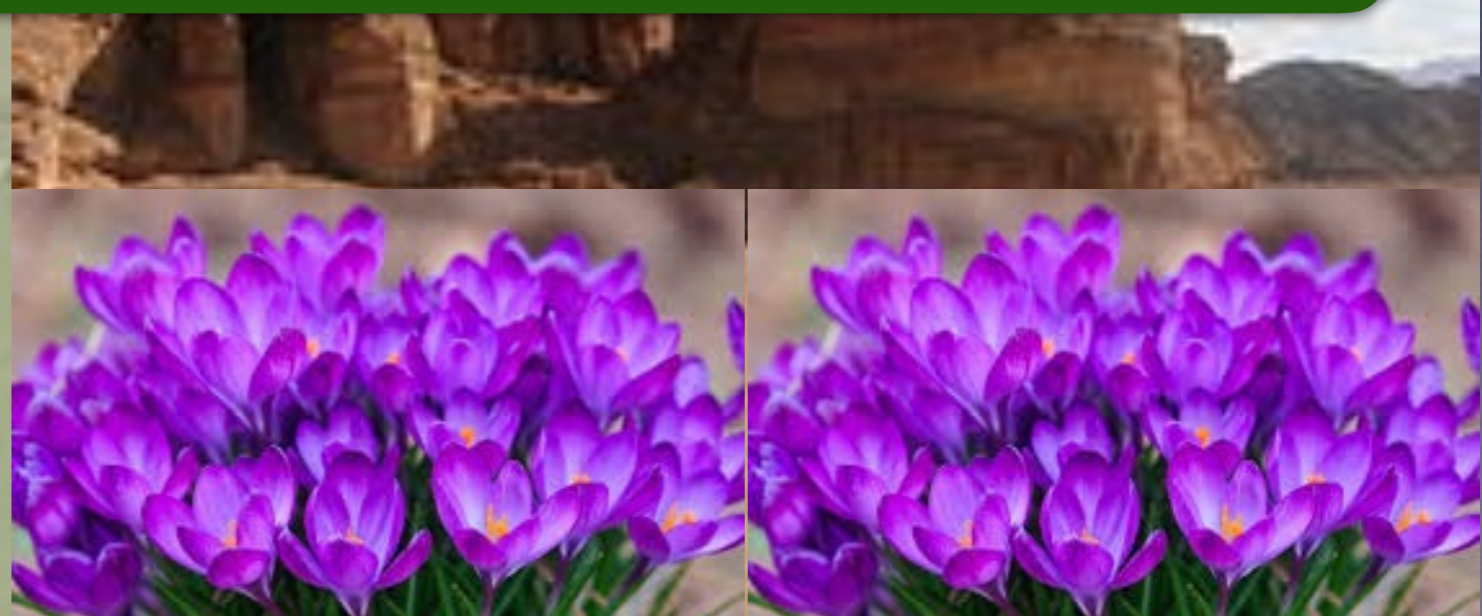






Romans 8:18–22

For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory that is to be revealed to us. For the anxious longing of the creation waits eagerly for the revealing of the sons of God. For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it, in hope that the creation itself also will be set free from its slavery to corruption into the freedom of the glory of the children of God. For we know that the whole creation groans and suffers the pains of childbirth together until now.

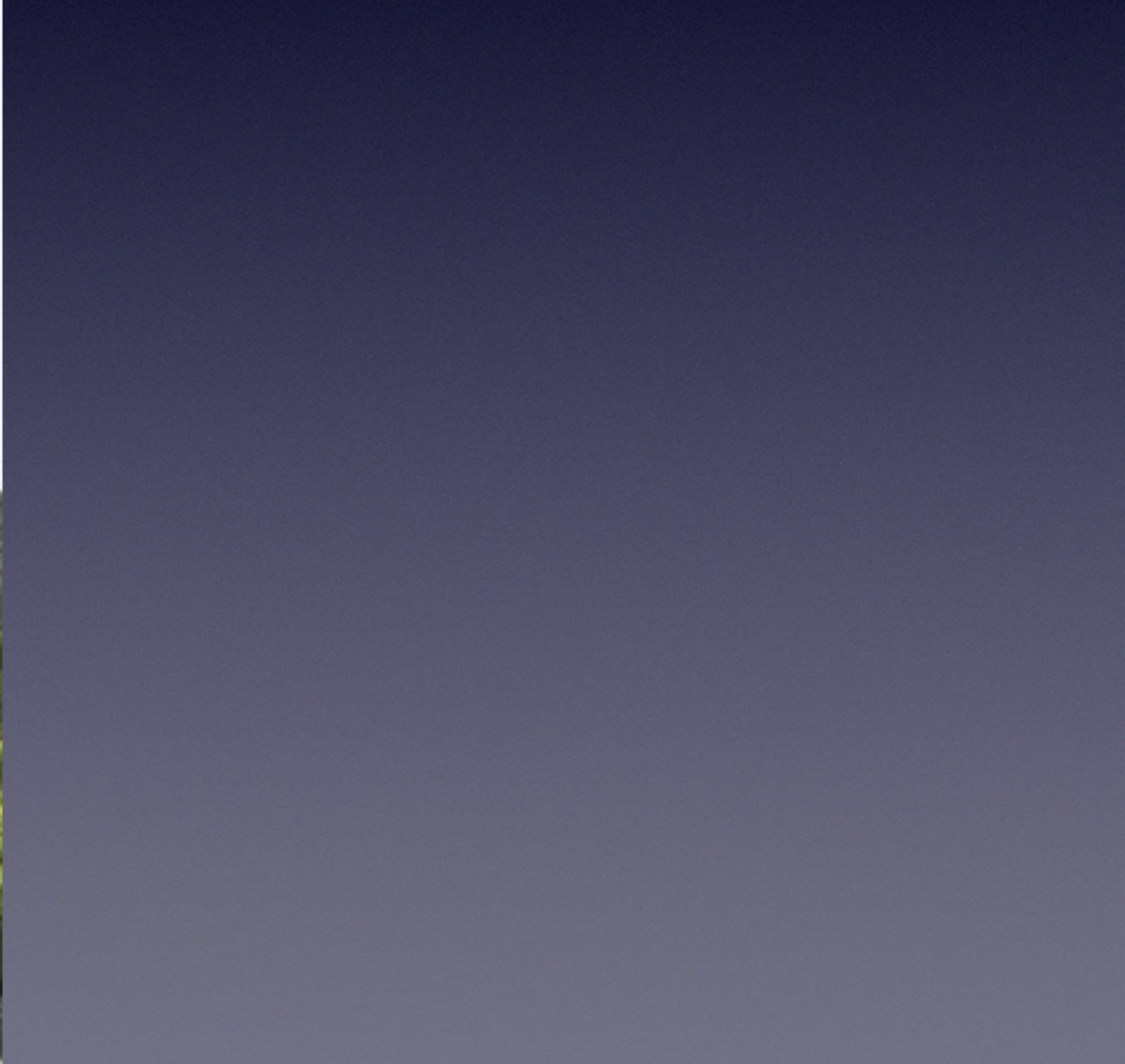
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The Lord's people will be glad - v. 10b
