

Genesis 1:28

²⁸ God blessed them; and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it; and rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

³¹ Whether, then, you eat or drink or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.




God's Plan for Marriage

Sin has marred marriage

Genesis 3:6–7

⁶ When the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight to the eyes, and that the tree was desirable to make one wise, she took from its fruit and ate; and she gave also to her husband with her, and he ate.

⁷ Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves loin coverings.

Romans 5:12–15

¹² Therefore, just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men, because all sinned—
¹³ for until the Law sin was in the world, but sin is not imputed when there is no law.

¹⁴ Nevertheless death reigned from Adam until Moses, even over those who had not sinned in the likeness of the offense of Adam, who is a type of Him who was to come.

¹⁵ But the free gift is not like the transgression. For if by the transgression of the one the many died, much more did the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abound to the many.



Your walk with Christ must come first!

Seek to fulfill your biblical role as a wife or husband

Study the Scriptures and seek to obey them fully

Make it your goal to glorify God – not change your spouse.

If your spouse is not pursuing the same objectives, don't be deterred from your purpose.

Remember the source of conflict

James 4:1–3

¹ What is the source of quarrels and conflicts among you? Is not the source your pleasures that wage war in your members?

² You lust and do not have; so you commit murder. You are envious and cannot obtain; so you fight and quarrel. You do not have because you do not ask.

³ You ask and do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, so that you may spend it on your pleasures.



Determine to biblically resolve conflict to the extent that you are able.

Romans 12:18

¹⁸ If possible, so far as it depends on you, be at peace with all men.



Respond biblically when you are treated unjustly

- 1 Peter 2:21–23
- ²¹ For you have been called for this purpose, since Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example for you to follow in His steps,
- ²² WHO COMMITTED NO SIN, NOR WAS ANY DECEIT FOUND IN HIS MOUTH;
- ²³ and while being reviled, He did not revile in return; while suffering, He uttered no threats, but kept entrusting Himself to Him who judges righteously;



Be quick to forgive!
