- 2) Three of the responses are favorable to the gospel.
- 3) Two responses look like genuine salvation initially but over time prove not to be.
- 4) Only a heart God has prepared will bear fruit with perseverance.

 - b) A mirror that helps us examine the reality of our own faith.
 - c) <u>An invitation</u> that offers the gospel.
