Sins of Commission

Colossians 3:5–8

- ⁵ Therefore consider the members of your earthly body as dead to immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and greed, which amounts to idolatry.
- ⁶ For it is because of these things that the wrath of God will come upon the sons of disobedience,
- ⁷ and in them you also once walked, when you were living in them.
- ⁸ But now you also, put them all aside: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and abusive speech from your mouth.

Sins of Omission

James 4:17

¹⁷ Therefore, to one who knows the right thing to do and does not do it, to him it is sin.

The proverbial saying conveys a stern warning against the sin of neglect. Not the sin of commission but the sin of omission is mentioned. Sins of Omission

James 4:17

¹⁷ Therefore, to one who knows the right thing to do and does not do it, to him it is sin.
