

Isaiah 53:12

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Isaiah 52:13-15

13 Behold, My servant will prosper, He will be high and lifted up and greatly exalted.

14 Just as many were astonished at you, My people, so His appearance was marred more than any man and His form more than the sons of men

15 Thus He will sprinkle many nations, Kings will shut their mouths on account of Him; for what had not been told them they will see, and what they had not heard they will understand.

Isaiah 53:1-3

- 1 Who has believed our message? and to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed?
- 2 For He grew up before Him like a tender shoot, and like a root out of parched ground; He has no stately form or majesty that we should look upon Him, nor appearance that we should be attracted to Him.
- 3 He was despised and forsaken of men, a man of sorrows and acquainted with grief; and like one from whom men hide their face, He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

Isaiah 53:4-6

- 4 Surely our griefs He Himself bore, and our sorrows He carried; yet we ourselves esteemed Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.
- 5 But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the chastening for our well-being fell upon Him, and by His scourging we are healed.
- All of us like sheep have gone astray, Each of us has turned to his own way; But the Lord has caused the iniquity of us all to fall on Him.

Isaiah 53:7-9

- 7 He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He did not open His mouth; like a lamb that is led to slaughter, and like a sheep that is silent before its shearers, so He did not open His mouth.
- 8 By oppression and judgment He was taken away; And as for His generation, who considered that He was cut off out of the land of the living for the transgression of My people, to whom the stroke was due?
- His grave was assigned with wicked men, yet He was with a rich man in His death, because He had done no violence, nor was there any deceit in His mouth.

Isaiah 53:10-12

- 10 But the LORD was pleased to crush Him, putting Him to grief; if He would render Himself as a guilt offering, He will see His offspring, He will prolong His days, and the good pleasure of the LORD will prosper in His hand.
 - 11 As a result of the anguish of His soul, He will see it and be satisfied; by His knowledge the Righteous One, My Servant, will justify the many, as He will bear their iniquities.
- 12 Therefore, I will allot Him a portion with the great, and He will divide the booty with the strong; because He poured out Himself to death, and was numbered with the transgressors; yet He bore the sin of many, and interceded for the transgressors.





Abrahamic Covenant

Genesis 12:1-3 - Now the Lord said to Abram, "Go forth from your country, and from your relatives and from your father's house, to the **land** which I will show you; and I will make you a **great nation**, and I will bless you, and make your name great; and so you shall be a blessing; and I will bless those who bless you, and the one who curses you I will curse. And in you **all the families of the earth will be blessed**."

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2 Samuel 7:16 - "Your house and your kingdom shall endure before Me forever; your throne shall be established forever."

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New Covenant

Jer. 31:33 - "But this is the covenant which I will make with the house of Israel after those days," declares the Lord, "I will put My law within them and on their heart I will write it; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people.

Ezekiel 37:24-28

"My servant David will be king over them, and they will all have one shepherd; and they will walk in My ordinances and keep My statutes and observe them. They will live on the land that I gave to Jacob My servant, in which your fathers lived; and they will live on it, they, and their sons and their sons' sons, forever; and David My servant will be their prince forever. I will make a covenant of peace with them; it will be an everlasting covenant with them. And I will place them and multiply them, and will set My sanctuary in their midst forever. My dwelling place also will be with them; and I will be their God, and they will be My people. And the nations will know that I am the Lord who sanctifies Israel, when My sanctuary is in their midst forever."

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Theme Statement

The light and the glory of the Lord is to be displayed through His people, enabled by the work of the Suffering and Exalted Servant and backed by the unconditional everlasting covenant of God.

1. The people of God are commanded to reflect the <u>light and glory</u> of the LORD God to a <u>darkened world</u> - v. 1-2

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- 3. There will be a large <u>ingathering</u> of <u>wealth</u>, <u>workers</u>, <u>former enemies</u> and <u>food</u> to Zion v. 5-11, 13-17b

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- 4. A Warning: The nation which will not serve Zion will be destroyed v. 12

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- 4. A Warning: The nation which will not serve Zion will be destroyed v. 12
- 5. There will not be any <u>violence</u> or <u>destruction</u> in the land, only <u>peace</u>, <u>righteousness</u> and <u>salvation</u> v. 17c-18
- 6. In eternity, the LORD God alone will be an <u>everlasting light</u> and His work of the righteousness of His people will bring <u>glory</u> to Him alone v. 19-22

The Covenant Work of the Suffering and Exalted Servant Isaiah 61

And He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up; and as was His custom, He entered the synagogue on the Sabbath, and stood up to read. And the book of the prophet Isaiah was handed to Him. And He opened the book and found the place where it was written,

- 1. The LORD God will not rest until Jerusalem is known by her <u>righteousness</u> and by a new God-given <u>name</u> v. 1-2
- 2. As a treasured jewel in the hand of God, Jerusalem will be renamed "My delight is in her" (Hephzibah) and her land renamed "married" (Beulah) v. 3-5

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Revelation 22:20 He who testifies to these things says, "Surely I am coming quickly." Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus!

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- 3. In the midst of the world's turmoil, be <u>encouraged</u> that we as believers are like oaks of righteousness planted by streams of water Isaiah 61:3; Psalm 1:3
- 4. Warning: The person who does not come in repentance and faith in the Lord Jesus Christ will suffer everlasting punishment Isaiah 60:12; John 3:36
