# Sovereign of the Storm

Mark 4:35-41

- I. When we are in the storm, it is always by Jesus' design (35-37).
- II. When we are in the storm, we often don't sense God's care and presence (38).
- III. When we are in the storm, we must remember Jesus can easily calm it—in His time (39).
- IV. When we are in the storm, it is a test of our faith (40).
- V. When we are in the storm, we should fear Christ more than our circumstances (41).



# What are the lessons for us?

1. Jesus Christ is utterly unique—He alone is the God-Man!
2. Jesus Christ is still sovereign over the physical creation.
3. Life's storms come at Christ's command, and we can choose to respond in only two possible ways...
  - ❖ Faith in Jesus' power over all creation.
  - ❖ Fear of our circumstances.
