#### Section Themes: The themes of this section answer several key questions:

- 1) How does the crucifixion of Christ on the cross glorify God? Our Lord's death, burial, resurrection, and exaltation display the splendor and majesty of God's perfect attributes more than anything else in the universe.**
- 2) What is our greatest need? Our greatest need is to be reconciled to our holy God. Have you come to Jesus in faith, knowing that He is your propitiation, the One who bore the penalty that you deserve?**
- 3) If you do know Him as your High Priest, are you crying out to Him for help when you are tempted? He is your merciful and faithful High Priest. Are you seeking His aid when you are tempted?**
