Memory Verse: "But we do see Him who was made for a little while lower than the angels, namely, Jesus because of the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, so that by the grace of God He might taste death for everyone." Hebrews 2:9

<u>Section Theme:</u> The theme of this section includes urgency and obedience couched in the timeless phrase "Today if you will Hear His Voice."

Israel failed to commit themselves to God in repentance and faith (cf. Ex. 17; Num. 14:22–23; Ps. 78:40–53) while experiencing firsthand His miraculous works and providential faithfulness.

By "Waiting for Tomorrow" to make a decision to trust in Christ the <u>informed unbeliever</u> further hardens his heart by inattention, thoughtlessness, unbelief, and disobedience.
