 - Don't have an evil, unbelieving heart that falls away from the living God
- The command
 - Take care that no such attitude is in your heart
 - Examine yourself and be on guard

Jeremiah 17:9 ⁹"The heart is more deceitful than all else And is desperately sick; Who can understand it?

Colossians 2:8 ⁸See to it that no one takes you captive through philosophy and empty deception, according to the tradition of men, according to the elementary principles of the world, rather than according to Christ.

Behavior of the Israelites

- They heard from God
- They sinned persistently for 40 years
- They were disobedient
- They were marked by unbelief

God's Response

- He was provoked
- He was angry for 40 years
- He sworn against them

Judgment Received

- Their bodies fell (died) in the wilderness
- They did not enter God's rest
