 - In the face of persecution, some Jews who had professed faith in Christ were tempted to abandon Christ and return to Judaism
- Three great themes:
 - 1. The incomparable greatness of Christ
 - 2. The danger of rejecting Christ
 - 3. Jesus is our great High Priest
