

- Observations
 - Grasp your need for God's help by facing obstacles in life head on

Officers instruct the people

3:2-4

- Follow the Ark!
- But keep your distance!

Observations

- Planning ahead is still part of following the Lord
- Following the Lord is keeping a focus on his word
- Maintain reverence and respect in your access to God

Joshua instructs the people

- Consecrate yourselves
- Wonders will happen among you
- Observations
 - Perceiving God's work requires a deliberate spiritual focus

Joshua instructs the priests

3:6

– Begin moving the Ark toward the river!

- Observations
 - God's Word should always be forefront in our activities

- God encourages Joshua
 - "I will exalt you"
 - "I will be with you"

- Observations
 - Humility precedes the Lord's exalting someone

- God instructs Joshua regarding the Priests 3:8
 - "Stand in the Jordan"

- Observations
 - Trust what is truly "a word from the Lord."
 - All else must be tested against Scripture
 - The Lord will be a steady reference while we pass through our trials
 - He who is first, may be last

Joshua comforts the people


3:9-13

- Signs of God's presence and promises
 - He will dispossess the land's inhabitants through you
 - The Ark is before you
 - He will have you raise a memorial by the end of the day
 - The waters will part like they did for Moses

Observations

- When it's time to cross through a trial,
 - The Lord is the only God in whom to trust
 - The Lord will provide any necessary final details
 - The Lord will provide confirmation after your obedience
 - The Lord will judge sin simply based on our conscience


Possible Timeline?

- Observations
 - Obedience is seen in everyone
 - The chain of command is functioning and brings order
 - There has been no murmuring!
 - The people have consecrated themselves
 - Joshua is confirmed as "Moses part 2"

Application Exercise

- Take a moment to <u>privately</u> list the trials of faith you are facing right now
 - Uncertainty in how God might be working
 - Fears you may be facing
 - New changes you may be anticipating
- Do a <u>private</u> self-examination of how <u>you</u> are facing these things
 - Worry?
 - Confidence in God, or self?
 - What is your "1st thought" or "response" when some new test comes your way?

Applications – Walking in Faith

- When trials come, we can be confident God is leading the way but we must have our hearts focused on his word and seeing things from his purposes
 - When God provides answers,
 - they may not be the answer we were hoping for
 - the hard work may still be ahead
- God continues to test our faith so that we learn to trust him even more – so details may be held back until they are needed. Therefore, we must be patient and trusting in his delay
- Confirmation of God's direction may only come
 AFTER we have taken the step into the water
