- 3. Taken from among men
- 4. Ministered on earth
- Minister under the old covenant
- 6. Death interrupted
- Offered sacrifices continually
- 8. Wore garments for glory and beauty

#### **Christ**

- 1. Believers **only** High Priest
- 2. A **Great** High Priest
- 3. Jesus, the **Son of God**
- 4. Ministers in **Heaven**
- 5. Minister of the <u>new</u> <u>covenant</u>
- 6. Continues forever
- 7. Offered up <u>Himself</u> Once and for all
- 8. Is <u>crowned</u> with glory and Honor

### Hebrews 10:11-12


Every priest stands daily ministering and offering time after time the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins;

This portable temple was built in the wilderness by the Israelites circa 1450 BC after they were freed from Egyptian slavery. The tabernacle was the first temple dedicated to God and the first resting place of the ark of the covenant. It served as a place of worship and sacrifices during the Israelites' 40 years in the desert while conquering the land of Canaan.

#### Heb. 9:24






#### Stats

### C. His Promise (Heb. 8:6)

- 1. Jesus is the Mediator of a Better Covenant
  - 1. Clearly Superior to the Levitical Priesthood

### Superior Priesthood because...

- ✓ Eternal
- ✓ Confirmed by an oath
- ✓ Founded on personal greatness
- ✓ Death could not interrupt it

- ✓ Only One Sacrifice
- ✓ Pure
- ✓ Full Access
- ✓ Saves Totall

### C. His Promise (Heb. 8:6)

- 1. Jesus is the Mediator of a <u>Better Covenant</u>
  - 1. Clearly Superior to the Levitical Priesthood
  - 2. Clearly Superior to the Levitical Ministry
- 2. Better Covenant enacted on **Better Promises**

### C. His Promise (Heb. 8:6)

- 2. Better Covenant enacted on **Better Promises** 
  - 1. New Covenant is an internal covenant
  - 2. Forgíveness of Síns

## Flow of the Argument

- 1. Major Premise: Jesus is a High Priest (v.1)
- 2. Mínor Premíse: Jesus cannot be a príest on earth (v.4)
- 3. Conclusion: He must be a high priest in heaven (v. 6)
