- <sup>32</sup>But remember the former days, when, after being enlightened, you endured a great conflict of sufferings,
- <sup>33</sup>partly by being made a public spectacle through reproaches and tribulations, and partly by becoming sharers with those who were so treated.
- <sup>34</sup>For you showed sympathy to the prisoners and accepted joyfully the seizure of your property, knowing that you have for yourselves a better possession and a lasting one.
- <sup>35</sup>Therefore, do not throw away your confidence, which has a great reward.
- <sup>36</sup>For you have need of endurance, so that when you have done the will of God, you may receive what was promised.
- <sup>37</sup>FOR YET IN A VERY LITTLE WHILE, HE WHO IS COMING WILL COME, AND WILL NOT DELAY.
- <sup>38</sup>BUT MY RIGHTEOUS ONE SHALL LIVE BY FAITH; AND IF HE SHRINKS BACK, MY SOUL HAS NO PLEASURE IN HIM.
- <sup>39</sup>But we are not of those who shrink back to destruction, but of those who have faith to the preserving of the soul.

- 1. A persevering faith <u>REMEMBER'S</u> how God worked in the PAST (vv.32-34)
  - 1. Remember how God <u>Enlightened</u> you (v. 32)
  - 2. Remember how you <u>Endured</u> a great conflict of sufferings (vv. 32b -34)
    - 1. You **Encountered** reproaches and tribulations (v. 33a)
    - 2. You <u>Engaged in sharing</u> with those who faced reproaches and tribulations (v.33b)
    - 3. You Empathized with the prisoners (v. 34a)
    - 4. You were <u>Elated</u> when your property was seized (v. 34b)

- 2. A persevering faith, focuses on RESOLUTELY doing Gods will in the PRESENT (vv. 35-36)
  - 1. To do God's will in the present, do no throw away your confidence in Christ (v. 35)
  - 2. To do God's will in the present, <u>courageously</u> endure (v. 36)

- 3. A persevering faith, <u>RELIES</u> on God's promises for the <u>FUTURE</u> (vv. 37-39)
  1. The imminent <u>return</u> of the Lord Jesus Christ (v.

  - 2. The Righteous will live by faith and will not retreat (v. 38 and 39)

- 1. A persevering faith, <u>REMEMBER'S</u> how God worked in the PAST (vv.32-34)
- 2. A persevering faith, focuses on RESOLUTELY doing Gods will in the PRESENT (vv. 35-36)
