## Destined for Glory! (Pt. 3) Romans 8:18-25

- IV. God has destined us for glory (18-25)
  - A. Our Future Glory Far Outweighs our Present Sufferings (18).
    - 1. "The Sufferings of this Present Time" (18a)
    - 2. "The Glory that is to Be Revealed to Us" (18b)
      - Seeing the glory of God!
      - Sharing the glory of God!
    - 3. The Comparative Weight of Suffering and Glory (18) "not worthy to be compared"

## Destined for Glory! (Pt. 3) Romans 8:18-25

- IV. God has destined us for glory (18-25)
  - A. Our Future Glory Far Outweighs our Present Sufferings (18).
  - B. Our Future Glory Provides Hope in our Present Sufferings (19-23).
    - 1. Now, All Creation Groans, But Eagerly Waits for Future Glory (19-22).
      - a. The Fact (19)
      - b. The Reason (20-21)
        - 1) God created the universe and it belongs to Him (20a).
        - 2) God cursed the universe and it is not what it was created to be (20b).
        - 3) God will renew the universe and it will be free of its curse (21).
      - c. The Picture (22)

## Practical Lessons ...

- 1. Don't underestimate the importance of the early chapters of Genesis.
- 2. Don't be deceived: humans can't destroy the earth or save it.
- 3. Don't be surprised, discouraged, or frightened by the sufferings of this life.
  - We will have troubles and trials in this world.
  - b. God will be faithful to sustain us in them and to use them for our good.
  - c. What awaits us in the future completely eclipses all the trouble here.
- 4. Intentionally think about your future glory to gain hope in your present sufferings.
