




























Real How are believers to pray?

With full, continual devotion (4:2a)

Luke 18:1 Now He was telling them a parable to show that at all times they ought to pray and not to lose heart,

Acts 1:14 These all with one mind were continually devoting themselves to prayer, along with the women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brothers.

Acts 2:42 They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.

Acts 14:27 When they had arrived and gathered the church together, they began to report all things that God had done with them and how He had opened a door of faith to the Gentiles.

Romans 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. 1 Corinthians 9:16 For if I preach the gospel, I have nothing to boast of, for I am under compulsion; for woe is me if I do not preach the gospel.

1 Corinthians 2:2 For I determined to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ, and Him crucified.

A Live and act in a wise manner (v5a)

- Includes having credibility at all levels
- Includes not creating needless obstacles that hinder relationships or believing the gospel
- Includes understanding the unique needs in approaching each person
- Includes living in a way that unbelievers will find attractive and noteworthy

A Make the most of every opportunity to share the gospel (v5b)

Luke 4:22a And all were speaking well of Him, and wondering at the gracious words which were falling from His lips

Luke 6:45 "The good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth what is good; and the evil man out of the evil treasure brings forth what is evil; for his mouth speaks from that which fills his heart."

A Live and act in a wise manner (v5a)

A Make the most of every opportunity to share the gospel (v5b)

Ephesians 4:29 Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such a word as is good for edification according to the need of the moment, so that it will give grace to those who hear.

Speak with grace (v6a)

1 Peter 3:15 but sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts, always being ready to make a defense to everyone who asks you to give an account for the hope that is in you, yet with gentleness and reverence;

Proverbs 25:11 Like apples of gold in settings of silver is a word spoken in right circumstances.

Closing

Communicate daily with God in heart attitude and prayer as you should

 Relate to the unbelieving world in a way that honors Christ and makes the gospel attractive
