### Three Ways to Group Israel

- 1. All the **physical** descendants of Abraham who are God's chosen people as a nation.
- 2. Two **spiritual** groups within the physical descendants of Israel...
  - a) Unbelieving Israel—those who have Abraham for their *physical* father, but not their *spiritual* father.
  - **b)** True spiritual Israel—the spiritual descendants of Abraham.

### Biblical Arguments Against Conditional Election

- 1. It ignores the fact that whatever God sees in the future, He has brought to pass (Eph. 1:11).
- 2. Biblical *foreknowledge* is not foreknowing something about a person but foreknowing a person (Rom. 8:29).
- 3. Jesus taught that people who would have believed given the chance were not elect (Mt. 11:20-24; Luke 10:10-15).
- 4. The Bible clearly teaches *unconditional* election.
