#### The importance of this parable

Mk 4:13 "Do you not understand this parable? How then will you understand all the parables?" ESV

2 <sup>nd</sup> soil – had a rocky substructure	seed sprang up and wither	red away				
3 <sup>rd</sup> soil – was crowded with weeds	seed grew up and was cho	ked out				
4 <sup>th</sup> soil – was well prepared	seed grew up and produce	d a great yield				
The parable was explained [8:9-15]						
The meaning of its elements						
The sower's seed is the Word [Mk], Word of God [Lk], Word of the Kingdom [Mt] - esp. the						
The sower is passing on the Word of God						
The 1 <sup>st</sup> soil represents those who have a heart – don't grasp the truth or refuse to pursue it						
The 2 <sup>nd</sup> soil represents those who	have a he	eart – initial interest, but abandon it				
The 3 <sup>rd</sup> soil represents those who		eart – initial interest, but slip away				

The 4<sup>th</sup> soil represents those in whom God has their hearts to be able to believe/obey

Of the four soils, only \_\_\_\_\_ represents those who come to true saving faith

The fruit represents a growing Christian character and an obedient life

### THE PARABLE OF THE LAMP

#### This parable is to be applied

and

[8:16-18]

#### The meaning of its elements

The light is Jesus as the Word of God

The lampstand represents how Jesus has been put on display

Externally - the word of God is to be shared and explained

Internally – the word of God is to be allowed to change one's heart into one of obedience

Lk 8:18 "Take care you listen" NASB

## THE PARABLES IN PRACTICE

#### **Obedient Listening Changes our Relationships**

[8:19-21]

To prioritize our relationships with other believers

To demonstrate our obedience to God's Word, not just hearing its words

#### **Obedient Listening Changes our Perspective**

[8:22-25]

To have a deeper trust in our Savior amid life's unpredictable trials

To comprehend even greater depths of the knowledge of our Lord

#### **Obedient Listening Changes our Service**

[8:1-3]

To find our own way to serve the Savior

#### **Application**

- Diligently seek to understand the Word of God by beginning with a willingness to obey the truth
  - Engage in regular study and mediation of the Word
  - He will provide an increase in your faith and obedience
- Allow the word to convict you of every hidden sin
  - Then let the light that is in you shine out to others
- Set your relationship priorities around the people of God in obedience to his Word
- When looking at the trials in life, let your faith grow through them
  - He IS in control, do not fear
