**Proverbs 2:1–22** 

In Proverbs 2 God <u>imparts</u> wisdom to the young by urging them to <u>pursue</u> more wisdom. The wisest thing you can do is pursue wisdom itself.

But why is it wise to devote yourself to pursuing wisdom?

Solomon composed a poem for his son(s) with two verses:

- I. Wisdom Is Worthy Work (1−11) 🕅
- II. Wisdom Is Deliverance (12–22) 7

1 Kgs 3 – 11 God said to him, "Because you have asked this thing [wisdom] and have not asked for yourself long life, nor have asked riches for yourself, nor have you asked for the life of your enemies, but have asked for yourself discernment to understand justice, <sup>12</sup> behold, I have done according to your words. Behold, I have given you a wise and discerning heart, so that there has been no one like you before you, nor shall one like you arise after you"

1 Kgs 4 – <sup>29</sup> Now God gave Solomon wisdom and very great discernment and breadth of mind, like the sand that is on the seashore. <sup>30</sup> Solomon's wisdom surpassed the wisdom of all the sons of the east and all the wisdom of Egypt... <sup>34</sup> Men came from all peoples to hear the wisdom of Solomon, from all the kings of the earth who had heard of his wisdom.
