Test or evaluate yourself to see if you are in the faith | 1 John

Put aside anger, wrath, malice, slander

Die to immorality, passion, greed, idols

Put on a heart of compassion | Col. 3

Let the word of God richly dwell within you

Flee from youthful lusts and the sin that entangles you

# the do not's of scripture

*Be free from that which offends our God...*

Do not repay evil for evil...vengeance is Mine says the Lord, I will repay Romans

Do not quench the Holy Spirit, or grieve the Holy Spirit I Thessalonians

Do not despise Biblical truths and commands

Abstain from every form of evil...lust of the flesh, eyes and boastful pride of life I John

Do not pass judgment, or have a critical spirit...usurping God's authority as Judge

Do not let sin reign in your body

Do not think more highly of yourself than you ought

Do not be hypocritical

Do not lose heart...despairing

Do not be bound to an unbeliever

Do not grow weary in doing good Galatians 6:9

Be not be deceived

Do not grumble or dispute Philippians

Be anxious for nothing...don't worry Philippians 4

Do not lie

Do not steal...anything, in any form, material goods, time, etc.

Do not be angry...giving Satan an opportunity

Do not deny God by your deeds, after having professed knowing Him Titus 1:16

Do not show partiality/favoritism James

Do not hate your brother

Do not say you have no sin

Do not love the things of the world...lust of the flesh, eyes & boastful pride of life I John

Do not practice sin...for that is of the devil
