Israel's Current Spiritual Condition (Pt. 3) Romans 11:1-10

- I. Israel's Current Spiritual Condition (1-10)
 - A. A Remnant Is Saved by Grace (1-6)
 - 1. The Question: Has God Permanently Rejected Israel? (1a)
 - 2. The Answer: Absolutely Not! (1b, 2a)
 - 3. The Proof (1c 4)
 - 4. The Implications (5-6)
 - a) There still exists a believing remnant (5a).
 - b) That remnant exists only because of God's choice (5b).
 - c) God's choice of the remnant is by grace alone (5b).
 - d) God's grace toward the remnant is completely apart from works (6).

The Implications

- 1. Every believer in Jesus Christ is part of the believing remnant.
- 2. The only reason you are part of that remnant is God's choice of you.
- 3. God's choice of you—and therefore your salvation—is not according to your works but by grace alone.
 - If any of your hope or confidence of being right with God or of getting into heaven is because of your own works, you are not a Christian.
 - If you are a Christian, verse 6 refutes the idea that God chose you based on His foreknowledge of your faith.
 - Since God didn't choose you because of your works but His grace, it's His grace and not your efforts that guarantee your final salvation.
