Context

Problem

The incompatibility of worrying and the Christian Life

- 1. Consider how God provides for the birds (v. 26)
- 2. Consider how God clothes the grass of the field (v. 28)
- 3. Consider the fact that those who do not have God as their father worry about these things (v. 32)
 - 1. Theory of Contingency
 - 2. Fatalism
 - 3. Doctrine of Certainty (Dr. Martin Lloyd Jones)

Solution (1/2)

- 1. The Appeal to God's Character
 - 1. God provídes (v. 26)
 - 2. God gives life and sovereignly determines our lifespan (v. 27)
 - 3. God's omniscience (v. 32b)

Solution (2/2)

- 1. The Appeal to God's Character
- 2. Prioritizing God
 - 1. His Kingdom (v. 33a)
 - 2. His Righteousness (v. 33b)

Application
