## Rom. 11:11-32 – Four Basic Propositions

- 1. As a whole, Israel has rejected her Messiah and His gospel (11-12).
- 2. Israel's rejection of Jesus Christ has resulted in the salvation of the Gentiles (11-12a).
- 3. The salvation of the Gentiles is currently leading to the salvation of a few from Israel (14) but will eventually lead to the ultimate salvation of all Israel (15, 25-26).
- 4. The ultimate salvation of all Israel will produce even greater blessing for the world (12b).
