Malachí 3:1-2 (NASB95)

1"Behold, I am going to send My messenger, and he will clear the way before Me. And the Lord, whom you seek, will suddenly come to His temple; and the messenger of the covenant, in whom you delight, behold, He is coming," says the LORD of hosts.

How is John the Greatest?

- ✓ He was <u>Chosen</u> by God to be the Forerunner of the Messiah
- ✓ His Mission was to <u>Prepare</u> the World for the Messiah
- ✓ He Urged people to <u>Acknowledge their Sin</u> and <u>Pointed to their need for Salvation</u>
- ✓ He was the <u>Last Prophet</u> and
- ✓ He stood on the <u>Edge</u> of the next dispensation

How are you and I greater than John?

- John died without seeing the fullness of God's Plan in Christ (Mark 6:17-29)
- + Even the Least of Us in God's Kingdom knows about and understands what the Cross has accomplished for the redeemed.
