The Bad Reputation of Shepherds

- 1. They tended to be a lower class of people.
- 2. They were wandering nomads.
- 3. They were often suspected of being thieves.
- 4. They were considered so dishonest that they were not allowed serve as judges or as witnesses in court.
- 5. They were usually under the rabbinic ban, not permitted to attend the synagogues or the Temple.
