- - 3 Jn. 2:18-21
- **≈ 2)** It turns the spotlight on the priority of Jesus' life.
  - The first 30 years of Jesus' life 0 verses.
  - His 3 ½ year ministry 10 chapters (1-10).
  - ™ The Passion Week 6 chapters (11-16).
- - In. 2:22 When He was raised from the dead, His disciples remembered that He said this; and they believed the Scripture and the word which Jesus had spoken.
