An Unjust Death, Peaceful Protests, & Violent Riots

- I. The Key Issue is <u>Justice</u>.
 - A. Our God is completely, unwaveringly committed to justice that is untainted by prejudice.
 - B. As those who call Him Father, we should be equally committed to justice without prejudice.
 - C. We should <u>pursue</u> justice.
 - We must root out the sins of partiality, prejudice, and hatred from <u>our own</u> <u>hearts</u>.
 - We should pray the truth will come out and justice will truly be done in this situation.
 - We should insist our leaders practice justice without partiality.

 - A. The Sin of Slavery (Ex. 21:16; Dt. 24:7; 1 Tim. 1:10)

A Gospel Response to Government *Romans 13:1-7*

- I. A Universal Command to Submit to Government (1a)
 - A. The Biblical Exceptions

1) The legitimate response by <u>individuals</u> to gov't abuses...

- a. Acknowledge and graciously speak against the sins and legal abuse of leaders (Dan. 5:22-23; Mt. 23; Mk. 6:18).
- b. Request a personal exception in the law (Dan. 1:8).
- c. Use all legal means provided by existing law.
- d. Flee unlawful and unjust arrest & punishment (Mt. 10:23; Jn. 11:53-54; Acts 9:23-25).
- e. Disobey the gov't only when they require you to break God's law (Acts 4:19-20; 5:29; e.g., Ex. 1:16-17; Dan. 3:18; 6:10).

2) The legitimate response by <u>subordinate</u> <u>authorities</u> in government to gov't abuses

- a. Use all the means available to individuals.
- b. Disobey when laws or executive orders will unjustly cause the death of innocents, <u>and</u> there are no other means (Esther 4:15-16).
- c. Disobey when laws or executive orders are contrary to the law of the land.
- d. Resist with force an unlawful, internal takeover of the government.
- e. Remove, with force if necessary, any government official seeking to replace the current government and its laws.

A Gospel Response to Government *Romans 13:1-7*

- I. A Universal Command to Submit to Government (1a)
- II. The Reasons to Submit to Government (1b-6)
 - A. God established the principle and structures of all human authority (1b).
 - 1. God is the only true, ultimate authority (2 Ch. 20:6; Ps. 24:1; 47:7-8; 103:19; 135:6; Dan. 4:35).
 - 2. God has delegated limited authority to people.

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- a. God gave **husbands** authority within marriage (Eph. 5:22-24; Col. 3:18; Titus 2:5; 1 Pet. 3:1).
- b. God gave **parents** authority over their children (Luke 2:51; cf. Eph. 6:1-3).
- c. God gave **elders** authority over the function and membership of a local church (Acts 20:28; 1 Th. 5:12; 1 Pet. 5:5; Heb. 13:17).
- d. God gave **human government** authority over its citizens (Dan. 4:17; 5:18-21; Jn. 19:11; Rom. 13:1-7; Titus 3:1-2; 1 Pet. 2:13-17).
