Death

1. Meaning:

"cessation of the life of the body; a separation of the immaterial soul from the physical body" (James 2:26)

- 2. Why? (Gen. 2:17; 3:19. Rom. 5:12, 17; 6:23)

Rapture

1. Meaning:

"Latin word *rapio* meaning to snatch or seize or remove by force" (1 Thess. 4:14-18; John 14:1-3)

2. 3 Views

- 1. Pre-trib Before the tribulation begins
- 2. Mid-trib During the tribulation
- 3. Post-trib After the tribulation

1. Meaning

"Refers to the 7 year period in which the righteous judgements of God will be poured out on the unbelieving world" (Matt. 24:21; Rev. 6-19)

 - 2. Post-millennialism May or may not be literal years
 - 3. Pre-millennialism Literal 1000 year rule

The Millennium

- 3. Where Rev. 20:1-7
- 4. Characteristics
 - 1. Jews and Gentiles
 - 2. Satan will be bound (20:2-3)
 - 3. Jesus will reign (Is. 9:6-7; Dan. 7:14)
 - 4. Jesus will reign through His saints (1 cor. 6:2; 2 Tim. 2:12)

- 1. The Judgement Seat of Christ (2 cor. 5:10)
 - 1. Timing: After Rapture Before 2nd Coming
 - 2. Who will be Judged: All Believers
 - 1. Our Works (1 Cor. 3:9-15)
 - 2. Our Words (Jam. 3:1)
 - 3. Our Motives (1 Cor. 4:5)
 - 3. We will also receive rewards (1 Cor. 3:14)
 - 4. Who will be Judged: All Believers

The Judgements (2/2)

- 2. The Great White Throne Judgement (Rev. 20:11-15)
 - 1. Timing: After the millennium before the eternal state
 - 2. Who will be Judged?
 - 1. Fallen Angels
 - 2. All Unbelievers (20:12)
 - 3. What is the standard? The Law of God (Matt. 7:21-23)
 - 4. The Ultimate Sentence Just, Public, Unchangeable and Eternal
