**Matthew 6:34** <sup>34</sup> "So do not worry about tomorrow; for tomorrow will care for itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own

Don't worry about the material necessities of life (v22)

#### Three(3) reasons why:

- 1. Because life is more than food and clothing (v23)
- 2. Because you are more valuable to God than the other things He easily provides for in creation (vv24-28)
  - Consider the ravens (birds)
  - Consider the lilies (flowers)
- 3. Because worrying in and of itself accomplishes nothing (v25)

Don't seek and don't keep worrying about such necessities (vv29-33)

- For pagans are known to seek such things (v30a)
- But Jesus' disciples are to: (vv3ob-33)
  - Seek His kingdom, remembering that your Father will give you what He knows you need
  - Don't be afraid, remembering that your Father has chosen to bring you into His kingdom

**Romans 8:32** <sup>32</sup> He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him over for us all, how will He not also with Him freely give us all things?

Don't seek and don't keep worrying about such necessities (vv29-33)

- For pagans are known to seek such things (v30a)
- But Jesus' disciples are to: (vv3ob-33)
  - Seek His kingdom, remembering that your Father will give you what He knows you need
  - Don't be afraid, remembering that your Father has chosen to bring you into His kingdom
  - Loosen your grip on earthly treasures by giving to others (v33a)
  - Tighten your grip on heavenly treasures(v33b)

Don't seek and don't keep worrying about such necessities (vv29-33)

Reflect on where you are building treasures to see the true state of your heart (v34)

#### Personal reflections:

- If/when you are in need, are you worrying, or trusting in your Heavenly Father who promises to provide?
- If/when you are not in need, are you seeking material things inappropriately?
- Is your heart pursuing heavenly treasures or earthly treasures?

## Be Ready! (vv35-48)

Be loyal and alert servants who are constantly prepared for your Master's return (vv35-38)

- They will be blessed because of their devotion
- They will be served by their master because of his love and joy over them

Consider the possible negative consequences if you are not prepared, and let that help motivate you to get ready (vv39-40)

The faithful and wise servant will be rewarded (vv41-44)

The unfaithful and foolish servant will be punished (vv45-48)

## Be Ready! (vv35-48)

#### Personal reflections:

- Are you ready for Christ the Master to return?
- Does your life and preoccupations reflect one who is alert, faithful, diligent, and desiring to please Christ whom you wait expectantly to see?
