- > Philemon (AD 60-62, during 1st Roman Imprisonment)
- > Ephesians (AD 60-62, during 1st Roman Imprisonment)
- ➤ Philippians (AD 60-62, during 1st Roman Imprisonment)

- ➤ 1 Timothy (AD 63, Released from Prison)
- ➤ Titus (AD 63, Released from Prison)
- 2 Timothy (AD 65-66, 2nd Roman Imprisonment and Execution)

Church planted by: Epaphras

Lycus River Ephesus. • Hierapolis Magnesia Meander River Laodicea Colossae Priene, 50 mi Miletus 4 Didyma 50 km Black Sea Rome Philippi Thessalonica. Troas Colossae Ephesus Syracuse Tarsus Antioch! **Paphos** Mediterranean Sea Cyrene Caesarea 250 500 mi Jerusalem. Alexandria __ 800 km 400

Colossae

- ✓ Province of Phrygia
- ✓ 100 miles east of Ephesus
- ✓On the Lycus River
- ✓Thriving city in 5th Century BC
- ✓Known for Black wool and dyes
- ✓Important hub for business
- ✓ Declined in importance by Paul's day
- ✓ Gentiles and Jewish population
