

John 3 - How One is Born Again

John 3:3

John 3:5

unless one is born again

unless one is born of water and the Spirit

he cannot see or enter the kingdom of God



Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols. "Moreover, I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. "I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will be careful to observe My ordinances" (Ezek. 36:25-27)

God's Sovereignty in Regeneration

"Do not be amazed that I said to you, 'You must be born again.'The wind blows where it wishes and you hear the sound of it, but do not know where it comes from and where it is going; so is everyone who is born of the Spirit" (John 3:7-8)

Jesus uses the illustration of the wind that is sovereignly controlled by God. In the same way God sovereignly choses who He will cause to be born again.





- "Holy Baptism is the basis of the whole Christian life, the gateway to life in the Spirit. Through Baptism we are reborn as sons of God. It is the sacrament of regeneration through water in the word" (ccc,1213).
- The faithful are born anew by Baptism, and receive, in the Eucharist, the food of eternal life" (CCC, 1212).



- "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life (John 5:24).
- I give eternal life to them, and they will never perish; and no one will snatch them out of My hand (John 10:28).

THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

not only does not teach the doctrine of Assurance of Salvation, it preaches and teaches against it. Why? The explanation is quite simple. As long as you are uncertain, you are dependent upon the Church, you are dependent upon the priests.

"Eternal" Has No End





- How can one who has been perfected forever be found imperfect? (Heb. 10:14).

(CCC, 841)




- "Without a single sin to restrain her...she became the cause of salvation for herself and the whole human race." (ccc, 494)

Catholic Priests are False Mediators




- Priest baptizes for regeneration and justification
- Priest hears confession and absolves sin
- Priest offers body and blood of Jesus in the Eucharist
- Priest imparts Holy Spirit in Confirmation
- Priest gives Last Rites
- Priest offers Mass for souls suffering in purgatory

righteousness was perfected divine justice was satisfied blood was shed redemption was paid and finished sins were forgiven reconciliation was achieved death was conquered salvation was secured




Catholics Deny the Work of Redemption is Finished


John MacArthur's Clarion Voice on Roman Catholicism

We Must Lovingly Confront Those Who Are Being Deceived


- Satan deceives the world with fatal errors often hidden beneath a thin veneer of truth.

Which Body of Water Describes Your Witnessing?






