1 John 3:16 We know love by this, that He (Christ) laid down His life for us; and we <u>ought</u> to lay down our lives for the brethren.

17 But whoever has the world's goods, and sees his brother in need and closes his heart against him, how does the love of God abide in him? 18 Little children, let us not love with word or with tongue, but in deed and truth. 1Cor. 13:4 Love is patient, love is kind and is not jealous; love does not brag and is not arrogant, 5 does not act unbecomingly; it does not seek its own, is not provoked, does not take into account a wrong suffered, 6 does not rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth; 7 bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

Col 1:26 (in reference to the gospel Paul preached, he said), it is, the mystery which has been hidden from the past ages and generations, but has now been manifested to His saints, 27 to whom God willed to make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. 1Tim. 1:1 Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus according to the commandment of God our Savior, and of Christ Jesus, who is our hope.

1Pet. 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. John 17:24 "Father, I desire that they also, whom You have given Me, be with Me where I am, so that they may see My glory which You have given Me, for You loved Me before the foundation of the world." John 17:3 "This is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent."

Eph 1:5 He <u>predestined us to adoption</u> as sons through Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the <u>kind intention of His will</u>, 6 to the praise of the <u>glory of His grace</u>, which He <u>freely bestowed</u> on us in the Beloved. Ex. 33:18 Then Moses said, "I pray You, show me <u>Your glory!</u>" 19 And He said, "I Myself will make all <u>My goodness</u> pass before you, and will proclaim the name of the LORD before you; and I will <u>be gracious</u> to whom I will be gracious, and will <u>show</u> <u>compassion</u> on whom I will show compassion." Psa. 96:2

Sing to the LORD, bless His name;

Proclaim good tidings of His salvation from day to day.

3 Tell of *His glory* among the nations,

His wonderful deeds among all the peoples.

Psa. 115:1 Not to us, O LORD, not to us, But to Your name give *glory* Because of Your <u>lovingkindness</u> (תַסָּדָ), Because of Your <u>truth</u> (faithfulness). John 1:14 And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw *His glory*, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, <u>full of grace and truth</u>.

Rom. 5:1 Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, 2 through whom also we have obtained our introduction by faith into this grace in which we stand; and we exult in hope of the glory of God.

Eph 1:11 In Him also we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to His purpose who works all things after the counsel of His will, ... 13 ... you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise, 14 who is given as a pledge of our inheritance. Heb 11:24 By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, 25 choosing rather to endure ill-treatment with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin, 26 considering the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures of Egypt; for he was looking to the reward. 1 John 3:2 Beloved, now we are children of God, and it has not appeared as yet what we will be. We know that when He appears, we will be like Him, because we will see Him just as He is. 3 And everyone who has this hope fixed on Him purifies himself, just as He is pure.
