Christian Ministry:

1. Involves Suffering (24)

#### How did Paul in his flesh fill up what is lacking in Christ's afflictions?\*

- 1. " Christ suffered as a *propitiator* (turning away God's wrath by offering Himself as a sacrifice) for the sins of people; Paul suffered in the *presentation* of the gospel of Christ through which sinners become saints.
- 2. " Christ suffered as a *mediator* to reconcile man to God; Paul suffered for the *maturity* of believers in Christ.
- 3. " Christ suffered to *establish* the church; Paul suffered to *equip* the church.

  - 2. Humility (Eph. 4:2; Phil. 2:3; Col. 3:12)
  - 3. Alertness (Matt. 24:42; 1 Cor. 16:13; Col. 4:2; 1 Thes. 5:6; 1 Pet. 5:8)
  - 4. Not Driven by Feelings (Eph. 4:14-15)
  - 5. Able to Resist the Devil (Jam. 4:7)
  - 6. Delay Gratification (Matt. 6:33,16:24-26; Luke 14:28; Gal. 6:9)
  - 7. Contentment (1 Tim. 6:6)
  - 8. Sense of Responsibility (Gal. 6:5; 1 Tim. 5:8).
  - 9. Involved in Serving (Mark 10:45)
