### Being Heavenly Minded

Col. 3:1-4

January 27th, 2020

#### Colossian Heresy

- 1. Only that which is spiritual is good, matter was evil (1:15-20)
- 2. One must follow ceremonials, rituals, and restrictions in order to be saved or perfected (2:11,16-23; 3:11)
- 3. One must deny the body and live in strict asceticism (2:20-23)
- 4. Angels are to be worshipped (2:18)
- 5. Christ could not be both human and divine (1:15-20; 2:2,3)
- 6. One must obtain secret knowledge in order to be saved or perfected and this secret knowledge was not available to all (2:2, 18)
- 7. It is better to combine aspects of several religions (2:10)

#### Being Heavenly Minded

- 1. Remember Our Present State
  - Our Condition
    - We have been raised with Christ (v. la)
  - Our Response (vv. 1b-2)
    - **Seek** the things above (1b)
    - Remember the position that Christ occupies (1c)
    - Set your mind on the things above (2)

#### What it means to be Heavenly Minded

- 1. Live as citizens of the world to come (Phil. 3:20)
- 2. Exercise true humility (1 Pet. 5:6; Phil. 2:3-11; Jam. 4:10)
- 3. Be peacemakers (Matt. 5:9)
- 4. Be busy evangelizing and making disciples (Matt. 28:19-20)
- 5. Hunger and thirst for righteousness (Matt. 5:6)
- 6. Be mindful of our true citizenship (Phil. 3:20)
- 7. Make it your aim to live holy lives (1 Pet. 1:15-17)
- 8. Love others, even those who are our enemies (Matt. 5:44)
- 9. Recognize the temporary nature of the present world (Col. 2:16-23)

#### Being Heavenly Minded

- 1. Remember Our Present State (1-2)
  - We have been raised with Christ
- 2. Remember Our Past State (3)
  - We have died and our life is hidden with Christ in God
- 3. Remember Our Future State (4)
  - We will one day be revealed with Christ in glory
