

Why was Jesus baptized?

- 1. It confirmed the identity of Jesus as Messiah & God's Son (Jn. 1:31-33; Mk. 1:11).
- 2. It fulfilled a perfect, righteous life for His people (Mt. 3:15).
- 3. It was repentance for His people (Mk. 1:4-5, 7-9).
