Matthew 12:40 ⁴⁰for just as JONAH WAS THREE DAYS AND THREE NIGHTS IN THE BELLY OF THE SEA MONSTER, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

Mark 8:31 ³¹And He began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders and the chief priests and the scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again.

Mark 9:31 ³¹For He was teaching His disciples and telling them, "The Son of Man is to be delivered into the hands of men, and they will kill Him; and when He has been killed, He will rise three days later."

■ The empty tomb

- The women come to the tomb with spices to finish preparing Jesus' body for burial (v1)

- The women enter the tomb
 - Two angels appear
- Mark 10:33–34** ³³saying, “Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and the Son of Man will be delivered to the chief priests and the scribes; and they will condemn Him to death and will hand Him over to the Gentiles. ³⁴“They will mock Him and spit on Him, and scourge Him and kill *Him*, and three days later He will rise again.”

John 2:19 ¹⁹Jesus answered them, “Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.”

The Resurrection of Jesus Christ

■ The empty tomb

- The women come to the tomb with spices to finish preparing Jesus' body for burial (v1)
- The women enter the open tomb and find it empty (vv2-3)
- Two angels appear and announce that Jesus has risen (vv4-8)
- The women report the news to the disciples, who don't believe them (vv9-11)
- Peter (and John) also come and find the tomb empty as well (v12)

The Resurrection of Jesus Christ

■ The empty tomb

- The women come to the tomb with the body for burial (v1)
- The women enter the open tomb
- Two angels appear and announce the resurrection
- The women report the news to the other disciples (vv9-11)
- Peter (and John) also come and find the tomb empty as well (v12)

John 20:6–9 ⁶And so Simon Peter also came, following him, and entered the tomb; and he saw the linen wrappings lying *there*, ⁷and the face-cloth which had been on His head, not lying with the linen wrappings, but rolled up in a place by itself. ⁸So the other disciple who had first come to the tomb then also entered, and he saw and believed. ⁹For as yet they did not understand the Scripture, that He must rise again from the dead.

The Resurrection of Jesus Christ

■ The post-resurrection appearances

- Jesus appears to Mary Magdalene (John 20:13-18)

John 20:13-16,18 ¹³And they said to her, “Woman, why are you weeping?” She said to them, “Because they have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid Him.” ¹⁴When she had said this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing *there*, and did not know that it was Jesus. ¹⁵Jesus said to her, “Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you seeking?” Supposing Him to be the gardener, she said to Him, “Sir, if you have carried Him away, tell me where you have laid Him, and I will take Him away.” ¹⁶Jesus said to her, “Mary!” She turned and said to Him in Hebrew, “Rabboni!” (which means, Teacher)...¹⁸Mary Magdalene came, announcing to the disciples, “I have seen the Lord,” and *that* He had said these things to her.

The Resurrection of Jesus Christ

■ The post-resurrection appearances

- Jesus appears to Mary Magdalene (John 20:13-18)
- Jesus appears to the other women (Matt 28:8-10)

Matthew 28:8–10 ⁸And they left the tomb quickly with fear and great joy and ran to report it to His disciples. ⁹And behold, Jesus met them and greeted them. And they came up and took hold of His feet and worshiped Him. ¹⁰Then Jesus said to them, “Do not be afraid; go and take word to My brethren to leave for Galilee, and there they will see Me.”

The Resurrection of Jesus Christ

■ The post-resurrection appearances

- Jesus appears to Mary Magdalene (John 20:13-18)
- Jesus appears to the other women (Matt 28:8-10)
- Jesus appears to two disciples on the road to Emmaus (Luke 24:13-32)

...others follow

The Road to Emmaus (vv13-27)

- Later that day, two disciples travel to the village of Emmaus and discuss all that has taken place (vv13-14)
- Jesus joins them, but they do not recognize Him (vv15-16)
- Jesus asks what they are talking about, and they are amazed that He seems unaware of what has taken place (vv17-19a)
- The disciples explain Jesus, including the reports of His resurrection (vv19b-24)
- Jesus explains Himself to the disciples, including how all that has taken place was prophesied in the Old Testament concerning Messiah (vv25-27)

Closing

- **The resurrection of Jesus Christ proves that:**
 - All His claims and teachings are true
 - The Father fully accepted Jesus' substitutionary life and sacrificial death for sins
 - He is the rightful judge of every person
- **The prophecies of these events are overwhelming**
